On behalf of Sierra Club, I hereby withdraw the seven Title V Petitions specified herein that were submitted by Sierra Club relating to air permits issued by the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality for the Independence and White Bluff Power Plants, both operated by Entergy Arkansas Inc.

Specifically, with respect to the Independence Power Plant (AFIN 32-00042), I hereby withdraw these three Title V petitions: i) Petition on Draft Title V Operation Permit (Draft Permit No. 0449-AOP-R7), dated October 19, 2010; ii) Supplement to October 19, 2010 Petition and/or Petition to Reopen for Cause on Title V Permit (Permit No. 0449-AOP-R7), dated February 24, 2012; and iii) Petition for Objection to Title V Permit (Permit 0449-AOP-R8), dated May 5, 2015.

In addition, with respect the White Bluff Power Plant (AFIN 35-00110), I hereby withdraw these four Title V petitions: i) Petition on Draft Title V Operation Permit (Draft Permit No. 0263-AOP-R7), dated January 27, 2010; ii) Petition on Draft Title V Operating Permit (Draft Permit No. 0263-AOP-R7), dated February 1, 2012; iii) Supplemental Petition and/or Original Petition on Title V Operating Permit (Permit No. 0263-AOP-R7), dated August 29, 2012; and iv) Petition for Objection to Title V Permit (Permit 0263-AOP-R8), dated May 6, 2015.
