



# Wood-Burning Heaters

Funding from the Inflation Reduction Act delivers cleaner air through grants, research and partnerships to cut fine particle pollution (PM<sub>2.5</sub>), improve indoor air quality and reduce climate pollution from wood heaters.



Nationwide, there are roughly **26 million wood stoves and fireplaces.**



Wood-burning heaters **emit harmful fine particle pollution** as well as climate gases, carbon monoxide and air toxics.\*



Exposure to particle pollution from wood heaters increases the risk of **asthma attacks, heart attacks** and **premature death.**

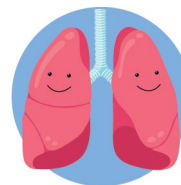
