Summary: EPA is finalizing changes to manifest regulations for shipments of hazardous waste that are exported for treatment, storage, and disposal. EPA is also finalizing regulatory changes to the hazardous waste export and import shipment international movement document-related requirements to more closely link the manifest data with the international movement document data. In addition, EPA is finalizing regulatory amendments to three manifest-related reports (i.e., Discrepancy, Exception, and Unmanifested Waste Reports) and making technical corrections.

State Authorization: This rule is placed in RCRA Cluster XXXIII. The State modification deadline is July 1, 2026 (or July 1, 2027 if a State statutory change is necessary). All provisions in the rule are promulgated either under the e-Manifest Act or HSWA import/export authority. The provisions of this rule will take effect in all States on the effective date of the rule, since these import and export requirements will be administered by the Federal government as a foreign policy matter and will not be administered by States. When a State adopts the e-Manifest or import/export provisions in this rule, they must not replace Federal or international references or terms with State references or terms.

Attorney General (AG) Certification Guidance: Specific AG certification of statutory authority may not be required for this checklist as long as the AG has previously demonstrated authority for the hazardous waste manifest.

Program Description (PD) Guidance: A State seeking authorization for this checklist should determine whether the revisions impact the program described in the Program Description.

Incorporation by Reference Guidance:

There are many provisions in this final rule which are non-delegable to states. See the rule checklist for details on the provisions whose language cannot be changed.
