<b>Action</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reconsideration of “Greenhouse Gas Reporting Rule: Revisions and Confidentiality Determinations for Petroleum and Natural Gas Systems” (89 FR 42062; May 14, 2024).</li> </ul>
<b>Reasons for Action</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Concerns that some monitoring requirements are unnecessarily burdensome, including those affecting smaller oil and gas producers.</li> <li>• Concerns that the rule is inflexible regarding the use of facility-measured data and monitoring technologies. We are working hand in hand with stakeholders to address these issues.</li> <li>• Improvements to this rule are critical as we work to reduce burden on oil and natural gas producers and restore American energy dominance.</li> </ul>
