Dear Mr. Deady:

In accordance with the regulations as adopted pursuant to Chapter 46-12 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, as amended, the Rhode Island Department of Environmental Management has terminated the above referenced Rhode Island Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (RIPDES) Permit as of the date noted in the attached termination. The attached termination and Statement of Basis includes the details of the permit termination.

The stormwater discharges from the facility at 498, 500, and 500B Washington Street in Coventry were authorized under the 2019 Rhode Island Multi-Sector General Permit (MSGP) on December 4, 2020. Per Part I.B.3.c of the MSGP, stormwater discharges with an existing individual permit are not authorized by the MSGP. Therefore, RIPDES permit No. RI0023868 has been terminated as of the authorization date under the MSGP, December 4, 2020. **Please note that the monitoring requirements under Part VI of the MSGP will become effective for the January-June 2021 period. The monitoring requirements under Part I.A.1 of RI0023868 remain effective for the current quarter (October 1-December 31). Therefore, a Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR) for the current quarter is required to be submitted by January 15, 2021 according to Part I.G of RI0023868.** A letter dated November 30, 2020, notified DEM of there being a new owner of the facility, Noramco Coventry LLC (Noramco). Starting after the completion of the building sale, Rhodes Technologies may submit a Notice of Intent (NOI) to transfer the coverage under the above referenced MSGP to Noramco.

PROPOSED TERMINATION OF A RHODE ISLAND POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMINATION SYSTEM (RIPDES) PERMIT TO DISCHARGE TO WATERS OF THE STATE

TYPE OF FACILITY: Manufacturing

The facility, which has been the source of the discharge, was issued a permit to discharge on May 5, 2015 and was administratively continued July 1, 2020. This facility is engaged in the manufacturing of active pharmaceutical ingredients (API) for use in finished dosage pharmaceutical formulations. The permit pertains to stormwater associated with industrial activity which is discharged to the South Branch of the Pawtuxet River through Outfall 001. On December 4, 2020, Rhodes Technologies was granted authorization to discharge stormwater through this outfall under the 2019 Rhode Island Multi-Sector General Permit (MSGP). The sale of the facility and its associated stormwater discharge and outfall to Noramco is anticipated to close on January 1, 2021.

BASIS FOR DEM'S TENTATIVE DECISION TO TERMINATE:

The permittee has been authorized to discharge stormwater through Outfall 001 under the MSGP. Per Part I.B.3.c of the MSGP, stormwater discharges covered by individual permits are not authorized under the MSGP. Therefore, in order to maintain permit coverage for Outfall 001 under the MSGP, the individual permit must be terminated.


