Re: Interim Contingency Plan Threshold modifications

Dear Mr. Hornbrook:

With this letter, EPA Region 1 acknowledges that we do not object to the two interim Contingency Plan Threshold modifications proposed in your January 3 2017 letter. Specifically, the proposed changes are to:

- · Delete the Contingency Plan Caution Level threshold for Phaeocystis; and
- Delete the upper range only thresholds currently tested for infaunal diversity.

These threshold modifications were discussed at the Outfall Monitoring Science Advisory Panel (OMSAP) meeting on October 27, 2016. Both the OMSAP and the Public Interest Advisory Committee to OMSAP support these modifications. The proposal was distributed via the EPA Region 1 electronic notification listserver for the Massachusetts Water Resources Authority (MWRA) Contingency Plan and no comments were received.

As you know, pursuant to the MWRA National Pollutant Discharge Elimination Program Permit Number MA0103284, Part I, section 8.c. these interim modifications must be included in an annual submission of proposed modifications by November 15, 2017. MWRA will continue to monitor *Phaeocystis* and infaunal diversity as per the monitoring plan.
