SUBJECT: Final Allotments for the FY 2026 Public Water System Supervision (PWSS) State and Tribal Support Program Grants

Attached for your information are the final fiscal year 2026 Public Water System Supervision Grant Allotments. The final amount available for funding the FY 2026 PWSS Grant Program is \$116,740,000, an increase of \$907,000 from FY 2025. This year's allotments include \$12,000,000 to support activities addressing per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS) and other contaminants of emerging concern. The state and Tribal support formula allotments were developed utilizing final FY 2026 funding levels, and the funds have been directed to the Regions' accounts.

Attached are the state-by-state allotments, and the total amount available to each Region for its Direct Implementation of the Tribal support program. For each allotment, the attachment includes the total amount, the funding for the general PWSS program, and the funding for PFAS and other emerging contaminants of concern.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is committed to a productive partnership with states, Tribes, and territories to maximize the impact the funds have in addressing urgent drinking water challenges facing communities. For decades, the PWSS program has been integral to the operations of the nation's public water systems. It supports the implementation of health protection standards for drinking water systems that serve the public.

Grant recipients may use their PWSS emerging contaminants grant funding to support their participation in PFAS OUT initiative activities such as attending, co-planning, and/or co-hosting regionally tailored webinars, reviewing and contributing state resources, coordinating outreach to systems, and fielding questions. All PWSS activities should be consistent with approved workplans, grant terms and conditions, and applicable provisions in 2 CFR Part 200. Recipients should consult their

EPA Regional project officer to incorporate these tasks into the PWSS workplan and budget and confirm that associated costs are allowable and reasonable.
